ANNUAL UPDATING OF LOG BOOKS

Due to social distancing guidelines this years updating of log books will be done as follows.

1. Members are required to pay Membership fees. (can be done immediately, the earlier the better! See page 11 to see how to pay online using a credit card).
2. Post logbooks to BSAOC of SA, C/-PO BOX 380, PLYMPTON, South Australia. 5038, together with :
 - i. Registration Papers, (if you don't have them, see note A. below)
 - ii. Registration Receipt (Tax Invoice) see note A. below
 - iii. Stamped Self Addressed envelope.
3. PO Box will be emptied on at least a weekly basis, and log books processed ASAP.
4. Log Books will be mailed to members Turn around times are expected to be 7—10 days.

Note:

- A. *Items 2i and 2ii can be downloaded from www.sa.gov.au. A 'my SA GOV' account will need to be created (5—10 mins). Or available at SA service centre, costs involved!*
- B. *It is recommended that pre-paid Aust Post satchels be used for this purpose, which can be tracked.*
- C. *If you are non-financial as at 1 Jul 2020, it is illegal to ride your bike.*
- D. *It is a mandatory requirement of the club to inform SA Reg of any non compliant members.*

OR

How NOT to lose club members on Club Runs.

- ♦ **Please arrive at club run departure points with a full tank of petrol.**
- ♦ **No passing the leaders of the groups.**
- ♦ **The leader of the run will point to the corner and the person immediately behind the leader will drop off and wait for 'Tail End Charlie' or the back-up trailer which ever is nominated at the beginning of the run, to pass. This way the run leader will know that all corners or change of directions are covered. This should ensure that the run stays together.**
- ♦ **No individual deviation from the designated run unless first advising the leader & Tail End Charlie - stick to follow the leader.**
- ♦ **Where possible lead and tail will wear Hi-Vis jackets.**
- ♦ **These guidelines are set down to keep the runs running smooth, please adhere to them for the benefit of all riders and accompanying cars including the back up trailer.**

- ◇ practise good hygiene






Saturday Run to Morning Tea




Saturday Run to Lunch




Saturday Run Home - Long & Short





The run then continued on the back roads to Carrickalinga & a beautiful scenic route it was.


A short ride through Normanville & we finished the run at the Yankalilla Memorial Park only a short walk to the busy Yankalilla Bakery.



I am only guessing but I think we had about 30 people there. It was nice to see the group, including our ladies, getting together as a club after the recent isolations.


